Where do you get the power to live your best life?

The Power For Your Best Life:

I. The Power of Persecution vs.


Saul was in <u>hearty agreement with putting him to death</u>. And on that <u>day a great persecution began</u> against the church in Jerusalem, and they were all scattered throughout the regions of Judea and Samaria, except the apostles.² Some devout men buried Stephen, and made loud lamentation over him. ³ But <u>Saul began ravaging the church, entering house after house, and dragging off men and women, he would put them in prison</u>. ⁴ Therefore, those who had been scattered went about preaching the word. ⁵ Philip went down to the city of Samaria and began proclaiming Christ to them. ⁶ The crowds with one accord were giving attention to what was said by Philip, as they heard and saw the signs which he was performing. ⁷ For in the case of many who had unclean spirits, they were coming out of them shouting with a loud voice; and many who had been paralyzed and lame were healed. ⁸ So there was much rejoicing in that city.

II. The Power of Sorcery vs. _____

Now there was a man named Simon, who <u>formerly was practicing magic in the city and astonishing the people of</u> <u>Samaria, claiming to be someone great</u>; ¹⁰ and they all, from smallest to greatest, were giving attention to him, saying, "<u>This man is what is called the Great Power of God</u>." ¹¹ And they were giving him attention because he had <u>for a long</u> <u>time astonished them with his magic arts</u>. ¹² But when <u>they believed Philip preaching the good news about the</u> <u>kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ, they were being baptized, men and women alike</u>. ¹³ Even Simon himself believed; and after being baptized, he continued on with Philip, and as <u>he observed signs and great miracles taking</u> <u>place</u>, he was constantly amazed.

III. The Power of Money vs. _____


Now when the apostles in Jerusalem heard that Samaria had received the word of God, they sent them Peter and John, ¹⁵ who came down and prayed for them that they might receive the Holy Spirit. ¹⁶ For <u>He had not yet fallen upon</u> <u>any of them; they had simply been baptized in the name of the Lord Jesus</u>. ¹⁷ Then they began laying their hands on them, and they were receiving the Holy Spirit. ¹⁸ Now when Simon saw that the Spirit was bestowed through the laying on of the apostles' hands, he offered them money, ¹⁹ saying, "Give this authority to me as well, so that everyone on whom I lay my hands may receive the Holy Spirit." ²⁰ But Peter said to him, "May your silver perish with you, because you thought you could obtain the gift of God with money! ²¹ You have no part or portion in this matter, for your heart is not right before God. ²² Therefore repent of this wickedness of yours, and pray the Lord that, if possible, the intention of your heart may be forgiven you. ²³ For I see that you are in the gall of bitterness and in the bondage of iniquity." ²⁴ But Simon answered and said, "Pray to the Lord for me yourselves, so that nothing of what you have said may come upon me."
