•	Matthew 1:18–19 Now the birth of Jesus the Messiah was as follows: when His mother Mary had been betrothed to Joseph, before they came together she was found to be pregnant by the Holy Spirit. <sup>19</sup> And her husband Joseph, since he was a righteous man and did not want to disgrace her, planned to send her away secretly. (NASB)

	Matthew 1:20–23 But when he had thought this over, behold, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream, saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary as your wife; for the Child who has been conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit. <sup>21</sup> She will give birth to a Son; and you shall name Him Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins." <sup>22</sup> Now all this took place so that what was spoken by the Lord through the prophet would be fulfilled: <sup>23</sup> "Behold, The Virgin Will Conceive and Give Birth to a Son, and they shall name Him Immanuel," which translated means, "God with US." (NASB)

	Matthew 1:24–25 And Joseph awoke from his sleep and did as the angel of the Lord commanded him, and took Mary as his wife, <sup>25</sup> but kept her a virgin until she gave birth to a Son; and he named Him Jesus. (NASB)
