What does loving God with all our mind look like?

The Attributes of the Renewed Mind:

I. The Renewed Mind is

Romans 12:3 For through the grace given to me I say to everyone among you <u>not to think more highly of himself</u> <u>than he ought to think; but to think so as to have sound judgment</u>, as God has allotted to each a measure of faith.

II. The Renewed Mind is

Romans 12:4–5 For just as we have many members in one body and all the members do not have the same function, ⁵ so we, who are many, are one body in Christ, and individually members one of another.

III. The Renewed Mind

Romans 12:6–8 Since we have gifts that differ according to the grace given to us, each of us is to exercise them accordingly: <u>if prophecy, according to the proportion of his faith</u>; ⁷<u>if service, in his serving</u>; or <u>he who teaches, in his teaching</u>; ⁸<u>or he who exhorts, in his exhortation</u>; <u>he who gives, with liberality</u>; <u>he who leads, with diligence</u>; <u>he who shows mercy, with cheerfulness</u>.
