The Broadcast Audio Engineer is responsible for mixing online audio for Sunday morning worship services (9:30a and 11:00a) and other special events as requested. The ideal candidate will have a heart for reaching people for Christ while striving to capture the atmosphere in the Worship Center and have it translate to engage our online viewers and ultimately, glorifying God through providing excellent audio.

- Attend rehearsals (Wednesdays 8-10p) as well as mix live band and preaching during Sunday Worship (7:30a-12:30p) (live band 20-30 channels, plus an additional 10 aux inputs: preaching, videos, ambient)
- Manage online audio systems signal flow
- Troubleshoot and resolve system issues as they arise
- Listen to the rehearsal tracks for music in advance
- Must have a teachable spirit while bringing your professional experience and knowledge to the team
- Assist FOH Engineer with setup and strike equipment
- Assist tech ministry budgeting, acquiring and maintaining AVL equipment

 - Develop an audio team to assist in live broadcast mix
