



Below you will find a list of the items your child will need for school this year. Most of the school supply items are typically used for community items, as we work on sharing, and taking responsibility for shared supplies. However, this year each student will have their own supply box. Please bring all items to Meet and Greet or the first day of school. Your child's classroom teacher may request additional supply items after the start of the school year.

2 plastic supply/pencil boxes (97 cent style from Walmart for ease of stacking—any color is fine and a GT name tag sticker will be provided for your child's boxes—one for school supplies, one for music)

1 box of Crayola crayons—24 count (regular size) *

1 box of Crayola markers—8 count (broad point; classic colors) *

1 small bottle of Elmer's glue *

6 large glue sticks (Elmer's or Lakeshore) *

2 large pink erasers *

1 yellow highlighter * (2nd and 3rd grade only)

1 pair of Fiskars blunt tipped (rounded) scissors *

2 packs of 12 or 24 count Ticonderoga pencils *

1 box of Crayola colored pencils *

1 set of headphones (earbuds suggested to fit in supply box) *

1 one inch 3 ring binder

3 vinyl pocket folders with prongs (one each—red, blue, yellow)

2 black and white marbled composition books (wide ruled)

2 primary journals (composition books with blank space at top and lines at bottom -K only)

1 pack of 4 Expo dry erase markers (all black, please)

1 container of Clorox wipes

1 bottle of hand sanitizer

1 bottle of anti-bacterial hand soap

1 roll of paper towels

1 large box of tissues

1 clipboard

1 \$5.00 gift card (Target, Lakeshore, Starbucks, Amazon, etc—for teacher incentives)

1 generously sized backpack (large enough for folders, artwork, and library books)
