“The LORD said to Cain, ‘Why are you angry? Why is your face downcast? If you do what is right, will you not be accepted? But if you do not do what is right, sin is crouching at your door; it desires to have you, but you must master it.” Genesis 4:6-7 (NIV)

2. YOU MUST TAKE _____.

Temptation comes from our own desires, which entice us and drag us away...So don't be misled, my dear brothers and sisters. James 1:14+16 (NLT)

And God is faithful. He will keep the temptation from becoming so strong that you can't stand up against it. When you are tempted, he will show you a way out so that you will not give in to it.
