2. Our ______.

The Lord says, "Let not a wise man <u>speak with pride about his wisdom</u>. Let not the strong man speak with pride <u>about his strength</u>. And let not a rich man speak with pride <u>about his</u> <u>riches</u>. But let him who speaks with pride speak about this, that he understands and knows Me, that I am the Lord who shows loving-kindness and does what is fair and right and good on earth. For I find joy in these things," says the Lord.

3. Our ______.

Do not love this world nor the things it offers you, for...the world offers only a craving for physical pleasure, a craving for everything we see, and pride in our achievements and possessions. These are not from the Father, but are from this world. And <u>this world is fading</u> away, along with everything that people crave. But anyone who does what pleases God will live forever. 1 John 2:15-17 (NLT)

<u>Don't be so naive and self-confident. You're not exempt</u>. You could fall flat on your face as easily as anyone else. Forget about self-confidence; it's useless. <u>Cultivate God-confidence</u>. 1 Corinthians 10:12 (MSG)

3. Put your ______ in ______.

<u>Trust God</u> from the bottom of your heart; don't try to figure out everything on your own. <u>Listen</u> for God's voice in everything you do, everywhere you go; he's the one who will keep you on track.

Proverbs 3:5 (MSG)

4. Be open to ______.

"And now, my children, listen to me: happy are those who keep my ways. <u>Hear instruction and</u> <u>be wise, and do not neglect it...For whoever finds me finds life</u> and obtains favor from the Lord; but those who miss me injure themselves; all who hate me love death.

Proverbs 8:32-33, 35-36 (NLT)

5. _____ and _____ that no sin deceives you.

<u>Search me, God, and know my heart</u>; test me and know my anxious thoughts. <u>See if there is any</u> <u>offensive way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting</u>.
