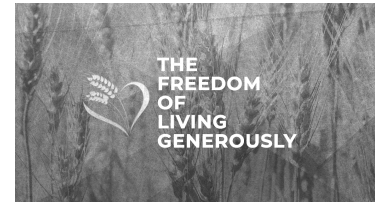

Matthew 25:14-30 (EHV)

[Jesus said] The kingdom of heaven is like a man going on a journey. He called his servants and entrusted his possessions to them.
Matthew 25:14

- **The Law of POSSESSION:**

To one he gave five talents, to another two talents, and to still another one talent, each according to his own ability. Then he went on his journey.
Matthew 25:15

- **The Law of ALLOCATION:**

The servant who had received the five talents immediately put them to work and gained five more talents. In the same way, the servant who had received the two talents gained two more. But the servant who had received one talent went away, dug a hole in the ground, and hid his master's money.
Matthew 25:16

After a long time the master of those servants came and settled accounts with them.
