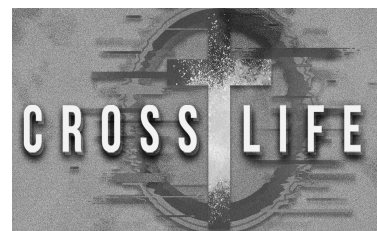

### WHAT WE LEARN WHEN WE SEE JESUS AS VAGABOND:

Cross Life RELOCATES us physically and spiritually.

Cross Life CHALLENGES our impulse to take CONTROL.

Cross Life FREES US from our compulsion to HOLD ONTO Jesus for our own reasons.

Cross Life reveals a God who allowed Himself to be PINNED DOWN so we could HIT THE ROAD with Jesus.
