

IT DEFINES JESUS' LIFE AND DEATH

IT DIRECTS THE LIFE OF GOD'S PEOPLE

WHAT WE LEARN WHEN WE SEE JESUS AS VAGABOND:

If you want to know Jesus, you've got to meet Him on the **ROAD**. He is **GOD IN MOTION**.

Cross Life RELOCATES us physically and spiritually.

Cross Life <u>CHALLENGES</u> our impulse to take <u>CONTROL</u>.

Cross Life FREES US from our compulsion to HOLD ONTO Jesus for our own reasons.

Cross Life reveals a God who allowed Himself to be PINNED DOWN so we could HIT THE ROAD with Jesus.
